

CCESSIBLE PARKING NOTES

- Accessible parking spaces shall be located on the shortest accessible route and such that persons with disabilities are not compelled to wheel or walk behind parked cars other than their own. Section II29B.4
- Single spaces shall be designed as detailed on this sheet, with the loading and unloading access aisle on the passenger side of the vehicle. Double spaces are permitted with the access aisle in the center of the two spaces.
- Entrance to and vertical clearances within accessible levels of parking structures shall be 8'2" to any structural member, duct, or pipe. Section 1130B
- Curb ramps shall lie, generally, in a single sloped plane, with a minimum of surface warping and cross slope. Section 1127B.5.2
- A level landing 4 feet deep shall be provided at the upper end of each curb ramp, or the slope of the fanned or flared sides of the curb ramp shall not exceed I unit vertical in 12 units horizontal (8.33% slope). Section 1127B.5.4
- The lower end of each curb ramp shall have a 1/2" lip beveled at 45 degrees as a detectable way-finding edge for persons with visual impairment. Section 1127B.5.5
- The surface of each curb ramp and its flared sides shall be stable, firm, and slip resistant and shall be of contrasting finish from that of the adjacent sidewalk. Section 1127B.5.6
- When less than five parking spaces are provided for a building or facility, one shall be 14 feet wide and lined to provide a 9' parking area and a 5' access aisle. However, the space need not be reserved exclusively or identified for use by persons with disabilities. Section 1129B.2
- Curb ramps shall be located or protected to prevent the obstruction by parked cars. Section 1127B.5.9
