Definition of Assistance Dog:

Assistance dogs are defined as dogs that are individually trained to do work or perform tasks for people with disabilities. Examples of such work or tasks include guiding people who are blind or have low vision, alerting people who are deaf or hearing impaired, pulling a wheelchair, alerting and protecting a person who is having a seizure, alerting a person to the presence of allergens, retrieving items, providing physical support and assistance with balance and stability, preventing or disrupting impulsive or destructive behaviors, or performing other duties. Assistance dogs are working animals, not pets. The work or task a dog has been trained to provide must be directly related to the person's disability. Dogs whose sole function is to provide companionship, comfort or emotional support do not qualify as service animals under the ADA.

"By affixing my signature to this affidavit, I hereby declare I fully understand that [Section 365.7 of the Penal Code](#) prohibits any person to knowingly and fraudulently represent themselves through verbal or written notice, to be the owner or trainer of any canine licensed as, to be qualified as, or identified as, a guide dog, signal dog, or service dog, as defined in subdivisions [\(d\), \(e\), and \(f\), respectively, of Section 365.5 of the Penal Code](#) and [paragraph \(6\) of subdivision \(b\) of Section 54.1 of the Civil Code](#), and that a violation of Section 365.7 of the Penal Code is a misdemeanor, punishable by imprisonment in a county jail not exceeding six months, by a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000), or by both imprisonment and fine."
